Parent Teachers' Association Fundraising & Event organisation

Our PTA is made up of a dedicated group of volunteers that love getting involved with the organisation of events, fundraising and community spirit. Events such as Mighty March Market, Disco's and Pizza lunches are organised by the PTA.

Commitment: Meetings can be up to twice a term and are held at school at 7pm. Communication is via a Whatsapp group or email. Donating time to help organise and run our school/community events is shared among the group.

Parent Voice - Whānau Connect



We value your input, and signing up for our Parent Voice group is one way to ensure your voice is heard. We couldn't run the school without the support we receive from parents and whānau and we offer a huge thank you to everyone who has already contributed in many ways to our school community.

Our **Parent Voice Group** has been set up so that our whole community can:

- help guide and support us when we need a sounding board, ideas, and feedback,
- support us with ideas for things that matter to you, for example; teaching and learning, attendance, curriculum development, achievement and aspirations, timing of meetings, homework, Hero posts, skills for the future, etc
- offer some local community expertise,
- allow us to hear your views and ideas so we can work together on your child's learning journey.

This is a group that you can dip in and out of when you want to get involved - a fluid group that has different voices on different topics as appropriate, and recognising Māori as tangata whenua. Contact may be through an email, Hero, a phone call, the newsletter, or we may hold the occasional meeting as a focus group for a particular topic.
