## **CATHERINE CLARE TO MATERNITY LEAVE**

As of 3pm Thursday 9 April 2020, Catherine Clare will be on maternity leave. As a school, we are very happy for Catherine and the Board of Trustees is supportive of her leave application. At this stage, her period of leave is for 3 terms, through until the end of 2020. The leave period will be reviewed later in the year and maybe extended into 2021. In order to cope with this situation and to provide the best possible learning opportunities for your child we have employed Ms Shannon Duffy. Shannon is working in Canada and will return to NZ in mid-March. When Shannon returns to NZ we envisage a practical transition period with a 'double teaming' of both Shannon and Catherine for the last week or two of Term 1. Shannon comes to us with impeccable references and is an experienced and talented teacher. I have every confidence in her teaching ability and I feel confident that she has the skill set to take your children successfully through until the end of the year. ## **THREE TEACHER ONLY DAYS IN 2020**

Over the next 3 years, primary schools throughout New Zealand will be able to close for up to eight Teacher Only Days without lengthening the school year. This situation has come about with the settlement of the Primary Teachers Collective Agreement in June/July of 2019. The provision of these days enables the government and teacher unions to address 'workload issues' without any extra salary costs.

Waikanae School will, therefore, be sourcing T.O.Ds from two separate pools.

**POOL 1.** Primary Teachers Collective Agreement. Eight T.O.Ds over 3 years with no extension to the school year. Waikanae School <u>will always hold these days during week 8 or 9 of Terms 1,2, and 3</u>

For 2020 these days are on the following dates SCHOOL CLOSED...Friday 27 March 2020 = Teacher Only Day 1 SCHOOL CLOSED...Friday 26 June 2020 = Teacher Only Day 2 SCHOOL CLOSED...Friday 11 September 2020 = Teacher Only Day 3

- Refreshing and deepening teacher knowledge and practice around the local curriculum (within the context of the removal of national standards)
- Teachers strengthening their understanding of the use of assessment tools for learning and teaching;
- Teachers responding to the recommendations of the education work programme in the Curriculum, Progress and Achievement (CPA) Report
- Teachers familiarising themselves with curriculum work changes that will become available over the term of the collective agreements.

**POOL 2.** Traditional T.O.Ds. These days are required to be made up and are taken out of the teacher's holidays. They are known in the trade as 'Call Back Days'. We deal with these days by either starting the school year earlier in Feb or closing later in December

The net effect of these two pools is that we will probably close during term time for up to four Teacher Only Days a year (1 per term) with the school year being shortened by 2-3 days per year.

Two of these days have already been held, Thursday 30 January and Friday 31 January.

#### It is our intention to ....

- Give plenty of notice to parents via Calendar, Newsletter, Facebook, School Website, School App and Linc-Ed.
- Make all days either a Friday or Monday to give parents the option of taking a long weekend.
- Link with neighbouring schools so that schools are closed on the same date.
- Ensure Funzone are available for parent-funded childcare.

#### **BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING 4 MARCH**

## **STUDENTS ARRIVING AT SCHOOL TOO EARLY**

It is very early in the year to be raising this issue with parents and whanau but we have a large number of families sending students to school before 8.30. As a result the school is considering keeping all classrooms locked until 8.15am. Our official opening time is 8.30 am and there is no supervision offered before this time. The only exception to this are the students arriving on the Peka Peka and Reikorangi school buses. This is a major Health and Safety issue and we cannot reasonably be expected to take on this role until 8.30am. We remind parents that an Out of School Care Service operates in the school hall every morning. 'Funzone' is the company that offers these child care services and their rates are very reasonable. It is likely that I will be ringing individual families whose students are arriving too early. The school is not a child care service so please either do not send your child to school prior to 8.30am or make use of the Out of School Care Service available.

## FOURTH NEW ENTRANT CLASS TO BEGIN WEEK 5 TERM 2

We will open our fourth New Entrant class for the year on Monday 25 May. This is the earliest that we have ever opened our fourth class. In fact, we are a whole term ahead of previous years and it is highly likely that we will need to open a fifth class later in Term 3. Mrs Moira Titchener will be teaching the class. As we have 21 out 21 classrooms currently full and two new classrooms to be built during the year we actually have no classroom spaces to put either of these New Entrant classes. Our solution to this problem is to close the Library until the two new rooms are completed. By mid Term 3 the Library space will be hosting a collaborative teaching/learning space with two tecahers and 20-30 students. The teachers will be Mrs Moira Titchner and Mrs Lisa Geraghty (upon return from Maternity Leave).
